#### What should you bring to your vaccination?

- Personal document (identity card, passport, ID card)
- Health insurance card
- Vaccination record
- Other important documents such as a "Herzpass" (personal emergency information booklet for heart patients), a diabetic card or a list of medications

#### Only if available:

- Completed medical history and consent form for vaccination against COVID-19
- Information sheet about vaccination against COVID-19

#### Which vaccines are administered?

Vaccination is carried out using the approved mRNA vaccine "Comirnaty" from BioNTech/Pfizer and the approved vector vaccine "COVID-19 Vaccine Janssen" from Johnson & Johnson.

Further information on the vaccines can be found in the information leaflets supplied by the RKI. Trained medical professionals and on-site physicians will take the time to provide comprehensive information and answer your questions about Covid vaccinations.
